Studio Policy 2015/2016

Fees and Payment

Payments are made at the beginning of each session (September and January). The session totals that appear on the fee schedule include:

- A set number of lessons
- Group Classes
- Recital Fee

Missed Lessons

- Students are required to give 24 hours notice when cancelling a lesson.
- Lessons cancelled with less than 24 hours notice will not be made up.
- A maximum of two missed lessons in the first session and three missed lessons in the second session (cancelled with 24 hours notice) can be made up before the end of the session. Any further missed lessons cannot be made up.
- The studio can only accommodate make up lessons if they are booked within ten days of the missed lesson. *It is the students'/parents' responsibility to book a makeup lesson with the teacher within this time frame.*
- Lessons that are cancelled by the teacher due to illness or unforeseen circumstances will be made up before the end of the session.

Group Lessons

Group Class dates for the entire studio year are published in September. Students are expected to attend all group classes. Tuition will not be altered should a student be unable to attend a group class.

Performances

There are two Studio Recitals each year, the first in December and the second in June. Students are also encouraged to take advantage of other performance opportunities such as festivals, competitions, master classes, RCM examinations, and community concerts.

Miscellaneous

Students should keep their fingernails cut as short as possible, as long fingernails hinder the development of correct piano technique. Please make an effort to trim long fingernails before each lesson.
